Passing the Programme

Each module is worth 100% and the pass mark is 40%. In order to pass the first University Examination and proceed to second year, students must pass the theoretical, practice and competency assessments in addition to the requirements for registration identified by Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann (2005). Calculation of Marks for Final Award

The following are the standards for the award of Bachelor of Nursing Science with honours. The computation of honours at the award level will be based on the following: Honours will be calculated on the basis of 30% of the aggregate mark obtained at 3rd year examinations and 70% of the aggregate mark obtained at 4th year examinations.

First Class Honours: H.1 = 70% on the aggregate. Second Class Honours: H2.1 = 60% on the aggregate.

H.2.2= 50% on the aggregate. H3 = 40% on the aggregate
